Getting To Know...

Jason Konvicka of Allen, Allen, Allen & Allen

How and when was your company founded?

In 1910, George E. Allen opened the doors of his new law firm across the street from the Lunenburg County Courthouse. He represented a diverse clientele including criminal defendants, bank depositors, elected officials, and citizens injured through the negligence of others.

After more than 20 years as a sole practitioner, Mr. Allen moved both his family and his law firm to Richmond in 1931 where he was joined in practice by his son George E. Allen, Jr. in 1935. Shortly after World War II, Mr. Allen's two younger sons, Ashby and Wilbur, passed the bar and began to practice law with their father and brother.

In 1951, the firm of Allen, Allen, Allen & Allen decided to limit its practice to plaintiff's personal injury litigation. Since that time, other attorneys, including a third generation of Allen family members, have joined the Allen Law Firm. Each one has aspired to uphold the guiding principle of the firm's founder, "that we find our lives in spending them in the service of others."

Including me, Jason Konvicka, the firm now has 22 attorneys and 8 branch offices serving Virginia clients in Richmond, Short Pump, Mechanicsville, Chesterfield, Petersburg, Charlottesville, Fredericksburg and Garrisonville.

What is the most enjoyable or exciting part of your business?

Without a doubt, the most rewarding part of my profession is helping people who are seriously in need. Many of my clients have had their lives suddenly and permanently altered by a profound injury. Helping those clients get their lives – work, personal, and financial – back in order is very fulfilling.

What is your tie to and connection with the Fan District?

My wife and I have resided in the Fan for almost 18 years. We are presently raising a family here as well.

What is the specialty of your business?
