- 2. The application must be *completed in full, with all materials mailed together*; incomplete applications will not be eligible for consideration.

V. REFERENCES

Your application must be accompanied by two letters of recommendation. At least one of the letters should be furnished by a faculty member at your present high school. The other letter can be provided by a teacher, faculty member, coach, employer, mentor or other adult who is aware of your challenges and your accomplishments. Letters of recommendation should not come from family members.

The reference should include a description of your success as a high school student, the obstacles you have overcome to achieve that success, and the extent to which your high school performance has improved.

VI. TRANSCRIPT

The applicant should have demonstrated academic progress during his or her four years of high school. A copy of your high school transcript is required.

VI. GUIDELINES

- 1. All requirements of your application must be postmarked by March 2, 2020. Any applications post-marked after March 2, 2020 will not be considered.
- 2. Please do not staple your materials.
- 3. Please submit all requirements of your application together in one envelope.
